Financial Assistance Program: Applications for tuition assistance are available online through PSAS.

<http://www.psas.org/onlineapp.aspx> Applications should be sent directly to PSAS by February 1st in order to be considered for the following school year. These awards are based on need. Award recipients are notified by St. Michael's finance department mid-March, prior to non-refundable tuition deposit.

Merit Scholar Program: St. Michael's identifies several merit scholars each year. Each scholarship is a renewable, annual grant of \$5,000. The total value of each scholarship is \$20,000! Merit Scholar applicants may also qualify for tuition assistance as described above.

Catholic School Student Qualifications

- Be a Catholic student graduating from 8th grade in June, 2010, from a Catholic elementary school sponsored by the Roman Catholic Diocese in the county of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside/San Bernardino, or San Diego.
- Earned grades of "B" or better in all grading periods during 7th and 8th grades.
- Earned grades of "B" or better in Responsible Behavior and Work Habits during the same period.
- Submit a letter of recommendation written by the 8th grade teacher and cosigned by the school principal.
- Have been accepted to St. Michael's Prep by Spring 2010.

Catholic Homeschool Student Qualifications

- Be a Roman Catholic homeschooled student living in Southern California and graduating from 8th grade in June 2010
- Be a registered member of a Diocesan recognized Roman Catholic parish in Southern California
- Submit a letter of recommendation written by your parish priest.
- Score well on the High School Placement Test (January 30, 2010)
- Have been accepted by St. Michael's Prep School by Spring 2010
